


CARDIAC SCREENING

590 players underwent cardiac screening during the year with 3 serious heart conditions identified. We were able to coordinate support for these members for potentially life-saving surgeries.

UPMC PRIORITY ACCESS TO CARE

22 players were supported with our "Priority Access to Care" initiative along with UPMC, fast-tracking scans, consultations and treatments for these members.



GAA INJURY BENEFIT FUND

There was an increase in loss of wages cover within the GAA Injury Benefit Fund. GPA members now have access to an increase in loss of wages cover from €600 for week 2-4, to €700 from week 2-10.



PAST PLAYER MEDICAL OR SURGICAL INTERVENTION FUND

9 past players accessed €80,000 in financial support through our joint GPA & GAA past player medical or surgical intervention fund.



PRE SEASON COMPETITIONS

We were successful in lobbying for the suspension of Pre-Season competitions for 2025, along with the implementation of the No Contact November period which will help with the aim of ensuring a proper off-season for players. We will continue to work with all key stakeholders to enhance its structure and implementation for the end of the 2025 season.
